TOPIC: Cleaning Large Equipment Windshields

Windshields on large machines are sometimes more than 4 meters (15 feet) off the ground. Safe access is rarely available and this hazard can be the cause of serious personal injury.

Use Proper Equipment

- Make use of tie-off points and other fall protection.
- Use stationary platforms.
- Use drive-through wash stations when accessible.
- Make use of long-handled squeegees.
- Use platforms and handrails.
- Do not stand on fenders or use ladders to access the windshield.
